Everything you wanted to know about agility trials but were afraid to ask! And everything trial secretaries, judges and trial chairpersons want you to know but hate to have to tell you.

You'll learn the nitty gritty details such as how to get your dog measured, how to do some of the volunteer jobs (a great way to save \$) such as bar setting and leash running, including how to properly set the double, triple and tire jumps. Volunteers are popular exhibitors and trials cannot happen without them.

We'll talk about over all trial etiquette - some do's and don'ts. Crating at trials and keeping your dog safe. Michele will talk about the common mistakes newer competitors make from her perspective as the judge in the ring. Essentially we will try to cover everything you need to know to make you feel comfortable going to competitions so that the only thing you have to think about is running your dog (and that's enough, right?)



Emphasis will be on AKC agility rules and customs but most pertain to other venues as well.
